FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ) MALAYSIAN TECHNICAL COOPERATION PROGRAMME (MTCP) SCHOLARSHIP 2025

1. I applied for the MTCP scholarship last year but was unsuccessful. If I reapply for this year, will my application be considered?

All applications are treated as fresh applications. If your application meets the requirements stated, it will be accepted for consideration.

2. I have submitted the application, what's next?

The application will be processed by the MTCP Secretariat. <u>Only shortlisted</u> <u>applicants will be invited for an online interview session via email.</u>

Your application is considered unsuccessful if you did not receive the email by 31 August 2025. You may also login into the application system from time to time to check on the status of application.

3. Who can be the referees for my Letter of Recommendation?

The referees for the Letter of Recommendation should be those who have the authority to provide information and comment on the applicant's performance in either academic or professional settings, and the applicant's potential and suitability to be awarded with the MTCP Scholarship. They could be the applicant's lecturers, supervisors and immediate superiors but cannot be family members, relatives and close friends.

4. How many Malaysian universities can I apply to?

Applicants may apply to as many Malaysian universities that are listed in the List of Universities Supported by the MTCP Scholarship that can be found in the website. However, applicants are required to upload only <u>one (1) valid and</u> <u>recent admission letter/ conditional offer letter</u> from the listed universities.

5. Do I need to apply to the university and obtain the admission letter first before applying for the MTCP Scholarship?

Interested applicants **must** secure a place in a Malaysian public university before submitting the scholarship application.

6. When can I expect to be called for the interview session?

Please be informed that <u>only shortlisted applicants will be notified for the</u> <u>interview</u> via email by July 2025.
